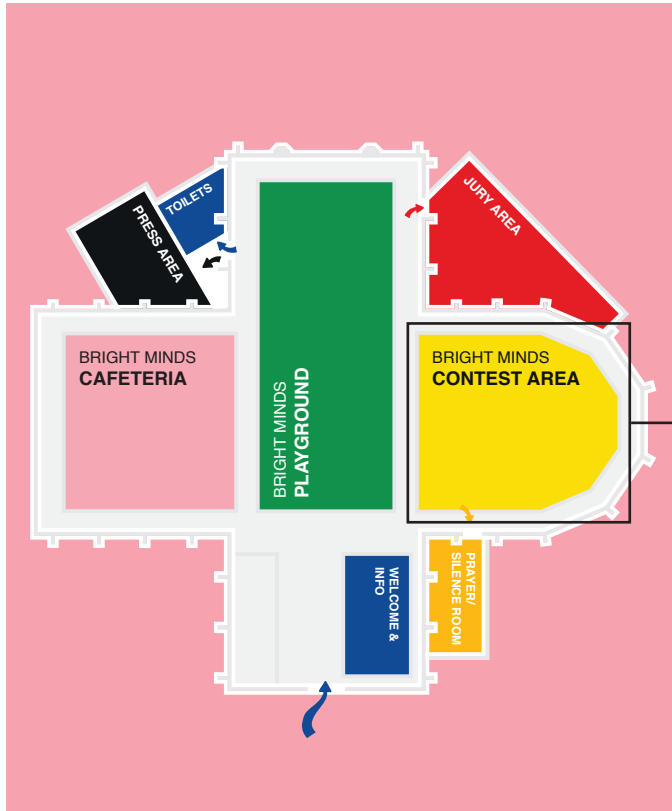
## **The Hooglandse Kerk will be divided into three zones:**

- 1** The Bright Minds Contest Area, where you will explain your project on your stand
- 2** The Bright Minds Playground, the area where companies, other organisations and musea are located to introduce you to different forms of science in an interactive way
- 3** The Bright Minds Cafeteria, the place where you will have lunch and where you get your drinks and snacks throughout the day. Don't forget to go outside during lunchtime to enjoy some fresh air!

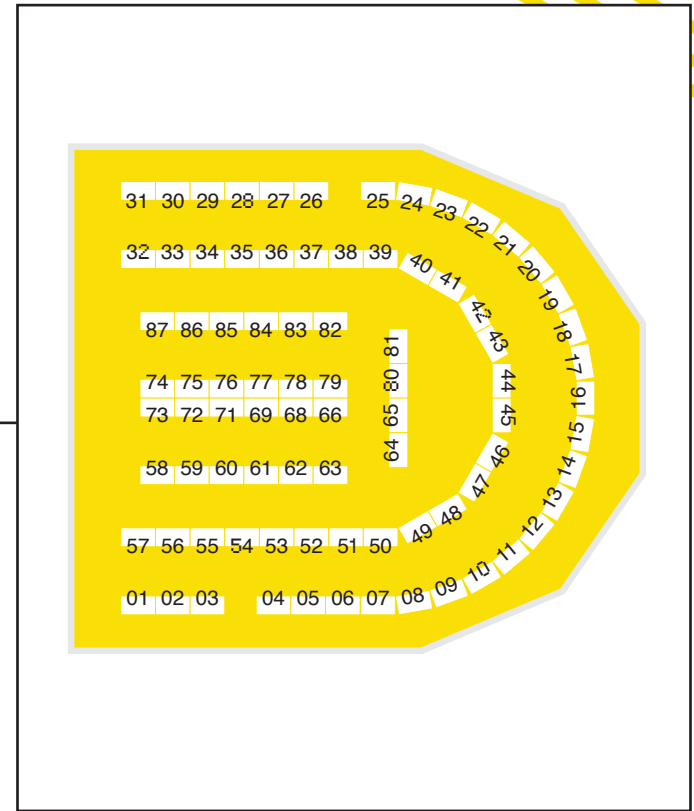

## STADSGEHOORZAAL

The Award Ceremony will take place in the famous Stadsgehoorzaal of Leiden. The Stadsgehoorzaal is a historical city auditorium that is located at the Breestraat 60 in Leiden. It was built in 1826 and it has had a rough start. For instance, there was a grand fire that burned down a big part of the building in 1889. Luckily, they were able to rebuild the building. The Stadsgehoorzaal has had more renovations done that all gave the building the look it has today.



## PESTHUIS

The monumental Pesthuis building will serve as our hangout for the evenings. The Pesthuis (English: Plague House) was built in the 17th century as a place to quarantine and treat sufferers of the plague, but it was never actually used for that purpose. By the time the Pesthuis was completed, the black death had virtually disappeared from the country.



# TAKE THE NEXT STEP

## MAIN PROGRAMME



### OPENING CEREMONY

The opening Ceremony will officially start EUCYS2022! After the opening, all invited guests will have the chance to visit your stand and talk to you about your project. 'Guests' include people who work in science, the government, students and other people of interest. No worries, no judge will be walking around yet, so take this chance to practice your pitch!

## PESTHUIS EVENINGS & DINNER

Our hangout for the evenings. This is where you will be served a simple, filling meal from a buffet between 18.00 and 20.00. Shared with others at big tables in the courtyard and in case of rain inside. We will also serve you some arts, games and culture. Think about a game of ping-pong, boardgames, a classic movienight, pop-up lectures and music.

## 1ST, 2ND, 3RD, 4TH, 5TH ROUND OF JUDGING

All bright young minds gather! During these judging rounds, you need to be at your stand. The jury will pop by to talk with you about your project. Every project will receive 5 jury visits. Of course there will be moments when you can leave your stand, which will be announced or passed on by the student helpers.


## AWARD CEREMONY

We will end EUCYS2022 officially with the Award Ceremony at the Stadsgehoorzaal, located in the city centre of Leiden. There, we will announce the winners of EUCYS. If you'd love to dress up, this is your moment! And if you don't, no worries, there is no

formal dress code. After the Award Ceremony, there will be drinks and some music. Just before the award ceremonies you are welcome to join the walking lunch.

## FAREWELL DINNER

After the reception of the award ceremony, we will head to the Hooglandse Kerk for the farewell dinner. This is where all participants of EUCYS and EU TalentOn together for festive meal only Harry Potter and his friends could dream off. At the same time, the city celebrates the ArtScienceWeek. This is an annual 7-day celebration of science, art and life. A perfect reason to connect science, art and local cuisine. All participants are invited to join this Big Tabel Dinner Show with long, wide theatre tables. These large wooden tables serve as both table and stage. The waiters will spread the special dishes out over the tables, various acts will leave everyone at the table in amazement and the host provides interaction by having everyone over these special tables interact with each other. All this is completed with the right table decorations, catering and lighting. Ofcourse, all catering is no meat.



## FAREWELL FESTIVAL: NIGHT OF DISCOVERIES

After dinner we walk in a parade to the farewell party: The night of discoveries. The Night of Discoveries is an annual event in Leiden, focusing on science and culture. Expect an amazing entourage and a more amazing program related to both science and culture. There will be a language no problem program.

## OPEN DAYS

All visitors to EUCYS2022 are able to talk with the participants at their stand during the judging sessions, provided that they do not interrupt the judging process. A great number of these visitors will be 15 and 16 year old scholars with a great interest in science. They would love to chat with you!

Leiden is made to wander through. There's no better way to soak up the city's past than by wandering through the historic city centre. The stories come to life all by themselves. From the young Rembrandt who roamed the streets and alleyways as a small boy, to the Pilgrims who settled around the Pieterskerk in the 17th century. The alleyways of Leiden also have great stories to tell. Thieves Alley, Brewster Alley, the names give away their secrets.

## FREE MUSEUM VISITS

Fancy visiting a museum? No other city in the Netherlands has so many extraordinary museums within walking distance from each other, offering a large array of nature, art, and culture. The Leiden area has 13 fantastic museums. We chose 4 for you to visit for

free. You can enter these museums during special times by simply showing your badge. Please be aware of the fact that all museums (except for de Hortus Botanicus) close at 17.00.



## HORTUS BOTANICUS LEIDEN

Found in 1590 on Rapenburg, the Hortus Botanicus in Leiden is the oldest botanical garden in the Netherlands. It really is a beautiful and interesting place. You can visit the Hortus Botanicus on 14, 15 and 16 September from 16.30 to 18.00 (last entry 17:30). Unlike other museums, their opening hours are longer. ## NATURALIS BIODIVERSITY CENTRE

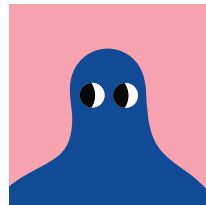

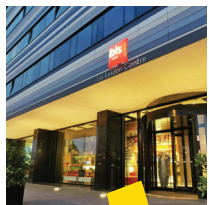

# RULES, PROHIBITIONS AND SAFETY

---

- It is not allowed to drink or buy alcohol under the age of 18.
- Adults are not allowed to buy alcohol for minors.
- Smoking is not allowed under the age of 18. Smoking in public buildings and in some public areas is not allowed.
